North Suburban Junior Tennis Association Filming and photography of NSJTA matches

(as at October 2011)

- (1) Filming video or photography of players on court is only permitted where:
 - (i) both players provide their express consent both to the filming/photography and to the purpose for which it is being taken (or, where a player is under 18, their parent or guardian provides express consent). The fact that a player or their parent/guardian does not object to filming or photography is not enough;
 - (ii) the host venue provides its express consent to the proposed filming/photography on its premises;
 - (iii) the host club supervisor is aware of the proposed filming or photography and retains discretion to require that filming or photography cease; and
 - (iv) a flash is not used.
- (2) Filming or photography is permitted off court for private and domestic use only. Photographs must not be sold, licensed, published (including electronically) or otherwise commercially exploited.
- (3) Filming and photography are strictly prohibited in restricted areas including change rooms.
- (4) At all times, the venue supervisor has discretion in relation to all filming and photography. Any person deemed to be acting inappropriately will be asked to cease taking photographs/film, may have their camera/video camera/mobile phone/other device confiscated whilst they are onsite or may be asked to leave the venue.

Note: These guidelines also apply to Junior Pennant matches, which is a Tennis Victoria run event.
